# Nachruf

GÜNTER SCHRAMM

Die Mitglieder des Concordia Club trauern um ihren Präsidenten Karl-Heinz Willi Bernhard Füsting, der am 10. Februar im Alter von 81 Jahren verstarb. Mit ihm verliert der Verein einen Mann, der den Verein in den letzten Jahren maßgeblich geprägt und gestaltet hat.

Karl wurde am 13. Juni 1939 in Loitz in Mecklenburg-Westpommern, geboren. Als Kind seiner Zeit wuchs er während der schwierigen Jahre des zweiten Weltkrieges auf.

Als junger Mann absolvierte Karl seinen Grundwehrdienst in der Nationalen Volksarmee in der damaligen DDR. Bald nach seiner Entlassung in das zivile Leben nutzte der freiheitsliebende Karl das Motorrad seines Großvaters um Heimat, Familie und Freunde zu verlassen. Durch das damals gefährliche Niemandsland floh Karl nach Westdeutschland.

Nach seiner Ankunft in der Freiheit vollendete Karl das in Magdeburg begonnene Studium als Maschinenbauingenieur an der Universität Stuttgart.

1967, im Alter von 28 Jahren, traf Karl die schwerwiegende Entscheidung allein nach Australien auszuwandern. Auf der „SS Galileo Galilei“ hatte er 6 Wochen Zeit über das Leben nachzudenken. Wie viele seiner Landsleute landete er in Sydney, ohne große finanzielle Mittel und ohne Kenntnisse der englischen Sprache. Jedoch gelang es Karl, auch Dank seiner treuen blauen Augen, eine italienische Familie dahingehend zu bezaubern, dass diese ihn zunächst aufnahm und ihm half, bei seinen ersten Gehversuchen im neuen Land erfolgreich zu sein.

Bald darauf, bei einer Sydney Hafenrundfahrt an einem sonnigen Herbsttag, schlug das Schicksal zu. Karl lernte Marja kennen. Es mangelte nicht an Zuneigung und 1972 wurde geheiratet. Ihre beiden Töchter Ingrid und Natalie und die Enkelkinder sind Zeugen ihres Familienglücks.

Im Berufsleben bewies Karl Fleiß, Unternehmensgeist und mechanische Fähigkeiten. Bei der Firma Rentokil stieg er zum Produktionsmanager und Fuhrparkmanager auf.

Karl hatte eine ganz besondere, jahrzehntelange Beziehung zum Concordia Club und zu der deutsch sprechenden Gemeinschaft in Sydney. Schon im Klub in Stanmore war Karl zeitweise ein wichtiges Direktionsmitglied. Er war einflussreich bei der Umsiedlung des Klubs von Stanmore nach Tempe.

Die Erfolge seiner Arbeit beeindruckten und im Jahr 2008 wurde er als Nachfolger von Reimer Schmidt zum Präsidenten des Concordia Clubs gewählt. Sein geschicktes Management und unermüdlicher Einsatz für den Verein zeichneten Karl aus. Aus Wenigem schuf Karl, auch mit Hilfe von Teresa Sonntag, einen erfolgreichen Verein.

Der wirtschaftliche Aufschwung Concordia's, nach guter Vorarbeit seines Vorgängers, ist zum großen Teil Karl zu verdanken. Er hatte ein besonderes Geschick, bei politischer Prominenz für Concordia zu werben und wurde selber prominent, wenn er im Klub von Tisch zu Tisch ging und für jeden ein gutes Wort fand.



# Obituary

The members of the Concordia Club mourn the death of their president Karl-Heinz Willi Bernhard Füsting, who died on February 10 at the age of 81. The club lost a man who has significantly influenced and shaped the club in recent years.

Karl was born on 13 June 1939 in Loitz, Germany and grew up during the difficult years of World War II. As a young man, Karl completed his military service in the National People's Army in what was then East Germany.

Soon after his discharge into civilian life, freedom-loving Karl used his grandfather's motorcycle to leave his home, his family and his friends. Through what was then dangerous no man's land, Karl fled to West Germany where he completed the mechanical engineering studies at the University of Stuttgart.

In 1967, at the age of 28, Karl made the decision to emigrate alone to Australia. On the "SS Galileo Galilei" he had 6 weeks to think about life.

Like many of his compatriots, he landed in Sydney without much financial means and without knowledge of the English language. However, thanks to his faithful blue eyes, Karl managed to charm an Italian family into taking him in and helping him to succeed in his first steps in the new country.

Soon after, on a Sydney harbour cruise on a sunny autumn day, fate struck. Karl met Marja, they fell in love and were married in 1972. Their two daughters Ingrid and Natalie and the grandchildren completed their family happiness.

In his professional life, Karl demonstrated diligence, entrepreneurial spirit and mechanical skills. At Rentokil, he rose to the positions of production manager and fleet manager.

Karl had a very special, decades-long relationship with the Concordia Club and the German-speaking community in Sydney.

Already at the club in Stanmore, Karl was a key board member. He was very influential in the relocation of the club from Stanmore to Tempe.

The success of his work impressed and in 2008 he was elected to succeed Reimer Schmidt as President of the Concordia Club. His skilful management and tireless dedication to the club set Karl apart. With the help of Teresa Sonntag, Karl created a successful club.

Concordia's economic upswing, after good preparatory work by his predecessor, was largely owed to Karl. He had a special knack for promoting Concordia among local influential people and became prominent himself when he walked from table to table at the club to have a chat with everyone.

One of his most important actions and matters of the heart was to remove the poker machines from the club in an effort to transform Concordia into a family friendly club.

It will be hard to continue his work and even harder to complete it.

Dear Karl, we all miss you very much and will cherish your memory.

To the Füsting family we extend our deepest sympathy.
